Contracted Position for Culturally Specific Services

The Women's Center of Beaver County is seeking qualified candidates to provide culturally specific services for Black/African American victims of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking to include:

- Representing the needs of African American victims at the County's Domestic and Sexual Violence Coordinating Team Meetings
- Providing training for the Coordinating Team, Victim Services, and other community partners on the provision of culturally-sensitive services and the needs of African American victims
- Working with the Coordinating Team and Victim Services to identify and problem-solve unmet needs and gaps in services for African American Victims
- Working to connect African American Victims to victim services and other community supports

Experience Required:

- History/Experience providing culturally specific services to the Black/African American population
- Experience working with trauma victims in a human service capacity
- Knowledge of and demonstrated partnerships with community resources/systems
- Basic understanding of the impact of trauma on individuals

Interested individuals/organizations need to submit a letter of interest and proposal for the provision of services that includes an hourly rate that is inclusive of all personnel, insurance, travel, and other administrative or incidental costs, as no other reimbursement will be provided beyond the hourly rate for services. Services will be provided January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2020. Contract will not exceed \$12,500 for the 2-year contract.
